Requirements:

As a professional Art Model you will be follow direction well, be able to remain stationary or hold poses for lengthy periods, and work cooperatively with instructors and students in a studio environment. As this position is casual in nature, flexible schedules are highly preferred. Reliability is essential, and art models **must be comfortable posing nude**.

We pride ourselves on providing a student-centered, learning-focused, and respectful environment. Please note that all body types are needed and no experience is necessary. ACAD will schedule models according to individual availability and instructor needs.

As a member of the AUPE bargaining unit (Local 071/006), this casual position pays an hourly rate of \$19.10.
